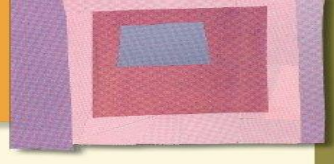

Helping us Understand The Bible

The supplements in this Bible were planned to provide the reader with helpful information about the Bible and some guidance in exploring it. The Bible should be read in its entirety, of course; but most Christian educators believe it is better to begin by reading it selectively. The material in these helps will enable the reader to choose passages of immediate interest for his exploration of the Bible.

From the time of the Greek Septuagint, nearly three centuries before Christ, the Bible has found its way into the languages of the people, often in the face of opposition by the ruling powers. Always there were dedicated scholars willing to defy kings and governments to bring the Word of God to the people. Because of this, the Bible is the most widely known book in the world. The purpose of these Study Helps is to help the reader know more intimately the One under whose inspiration the Bible was written.
